South Park Yardmaster

Responsibilities

The South Park Yardmaster is responsible for managing all operations in the South Park Yard. This includes:

- Ensuring the safe arrival and departure of all trains consistent with established schedules.
- Ensuring the industries of South Park are serviced according to switch lists and manifests.

Procedures

Arriving Trains:

- The dispatcher should notify the yard master in advance of arriving trains.
- Use the A-D and main tracks as necessary for arriving and departing trains.
- Receive train manifests from the arriving crew. Remind crew to notify the dispatcher of their arrival.
- Move power from the train to the engine service facility or other designated track if the facility is full.
- Classify cars on the classification tracks as indicated on the train manifest. After classification, return the completed manifests to the Dispatcher.

Departing Trains:

- Prepare departing trains based on the schedule provided.
- Assemble departing trains on the A-D track (and the main if necessary).
 - Block cars as defined on the manifest.
 - All trains leaving yard limits must use a caboose.
- Train crews may move power from the engine service facility to the departure track to assist the Yardmaster if necessary.
- Notify the Dispatcher when the train is ready for crew call. Provide the train symbol, total train length (# of cars), and lead engine number for all departing trains.
- Provide the outgoing crew with departing train manifest.

Other:

- Area track diagrams are located on the fascia.
