



# Zone Jobs

## Responsibilities

The three zone switch jobs are worked out of Lindenwood Yard, under the supervision of the Lindenwood Yard Master. The three zones are 1) Ellendale, 2) Shrewsbury, and 3) Chouteau.

Power is assigned by the Yard Master. Zone 3 is the only job requiring a caboose, which should be a transfer style caboose whenever possible.

### ZONE 1 – ELLENDALE

The Ellendale Neighborhood is the home of Lindenwood Yard. Zone 1 industries include a team track, Lammert Furniture Company warehouse, Commercial Propane, and Midland Metals. On the prototype, only the team track actually existed from the industries modelled on the layout.

### ZONE 2 – SHREWSBURY

Both a trailing-point and facing-point spur in this neighborhood require that 2 trips be made between the yard and the spurs. There are no run-around tracks available at this location. Travelling from the yard, the facing point spur houses Osage Box Company, Mizerany Warehouse, and C. Griswald Manufacturing. The Trailing point spur is home to Kroger Bakery Division and Cupples Manufacturing.

### ZONE 3 – CHOUTEAU

This St. Louis neighborhood is host to a Central Hardware Warehouse, the Spring Ave. Team Track, Reis-Moran Lumber Company, and Mound City Fruit & Produce. A transfer caboose is required for this job.
