



ANHEUSER-BUSCH TURN

Responsibilities

Run train from Twelfth Street Yard to the Anheuser-Busch Plant, which is located near the Soulard Neighborhood. Exchange cars and make any interplant moves requested by management, and listed on train manifest. Return to Twelfth Street Yard with cars picked up from the brewery.

This train may be using borrowed power from the Missouri Pacific Lines while MRS locomotives are not available.

Typical work at the brewery may include:

- Move empty grain hoppers from grain loading tracks to cleanout track.
- Move cars from cleanout track to mash track for loading with spent grain.
- Spot empty boxcars and pick up loaded boxcars of beer at the shipping docks.
- Spot loaded cars of hops & pick up empty insulated boxcars at the cold storage building.
- Pick up empty boxcars & spot loaded ones of bottles, bottle caps, packaging materials and other items at the receiving dock (Building #6).
- Pick up empty covered hoppers & deliver loaded ones of diatomaceous earth at the mineral silos.
- Deliver covered hoppers of wheat and barley to the grain unloading tracks.
- Pick up empty covered hoppers and covered hoppers loaded with mash (spent grain).
- Deliver coal loads to fuel track and pick up empty coal hoppers.
- Spot empty gondola to the cullet track and pick up gondola loaded with broken glass.
